The intensity of the sequence of events for the apostles, Mary, and others with them is almost beyond imagining. What I find heartening is that they had each other. In this time between everything they had known before and the vast unknown ahead, they were praying together in the familiar space of the upper room. All of us go through major transitions, sometimes reversals, that leave us shocked and bewildered.

Beloved God, when we are thrust into the unknown, hold us in the upper room of your loving heart. Help us trust that, like the apostles, somehow your Spirit will show us the way.

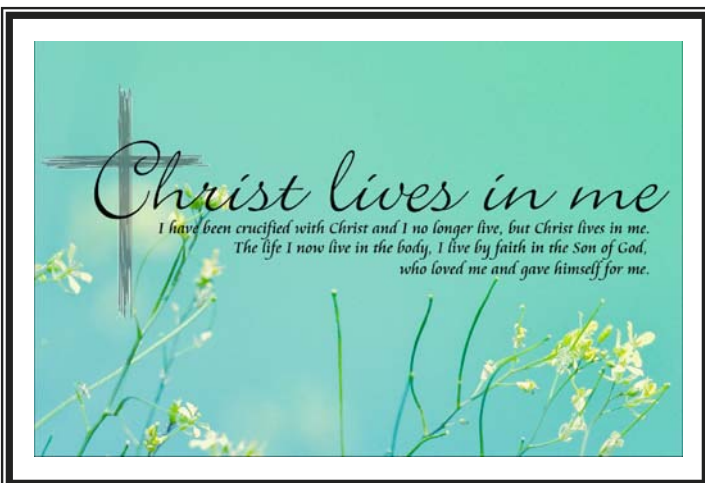
STEWARDSHIP & JESUS’ EXPECTATIONS...

Our first reading is from the *Book of Acts*. In fact, it is the beginning of that Book. *Acts* was written by **St. Luke**. It is a continuation of his Gospel in many ways. We do not learn that much about **Luke** from the New Testament. Most historians agree that he was a doctor; he was a Gentile; and he was a companion of **St. Paul**.

Acts is basically the continuation of Jesus’ work as described in the Gospels. In effect it describes how the Good News traveled from Jerusalem to Rome. Our readings today are filled with reminders that Jesus’ work is not completed. He commissioned His followers to continue it after His Ascension into Heaven. Among those commissioned so to speak is each of us.

The Lord’s work continues from that day to today. However, for it to continue and for the love He shared and displayed to be the factor, it needs to be in our parish and in the Church and in the world it is reliant upon us.

It was **St. Teresa of Avila** who wrote, *Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which He looks compassion on this world. Yours are the feet with which He walks to do good. Yours are the hands through which He blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, you are His Body. Christ has no body now on earth but yours.* Ω



STEWARDSHIP & MEMORIAL DAY...



Memorial Day was originally known as Decoration Day. The current name for this day did not come into use until after World War II. Decoration Day, and then Memorial Day used to be held on May 30, regardless of the day of the week on which it fell. In 1968, the *Uniform Holidays Bill* was passed as part of a move to use federal holidays to create three-day weekends. This meant that beginning in 1971, **Memorial Day** holiday has been officially observed on the last Monday in May.

Instituted to honor those men and women who have died in service to our country, it has expanded in many places to a time to remember and honor our dead. Regardless how you choose to commemorate **Memorial Day**, each person and each family should set aside some time to remember and pray for those who have given their lives so we can enjoy the freedom of this country.

As we remember those who have made the ultimate sacrifice for the freedoms we enjoy every day, we think of how they have followed in the footsteps of Your Son, our Savior, Jesus Christ. 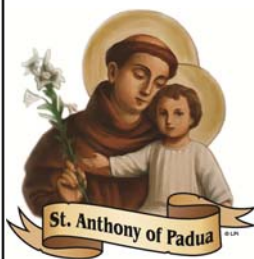

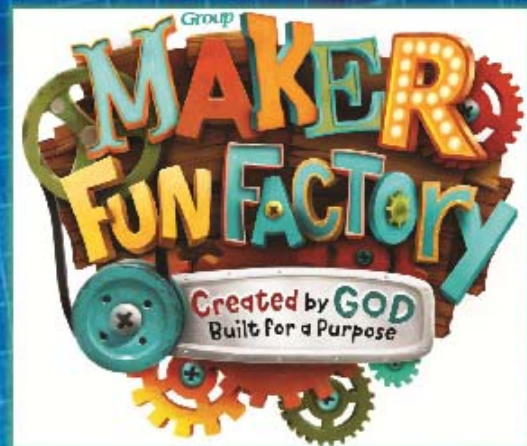
