Wisdom With Aging

Significant details that are not part of today's reading from 1 Samuel, reveal a vital part of Samuel's experience. The second verse tells us that Samuel's mentor, Eli, is an elder whose "eyes had lately grown so weak that he could not see" (verse 2). Eli's external blindness contrasts with his vivid, inner seeing. When Samuel thinks his mentor is calling him, Eli tells the youth to go back to sleep. Finally, Eli realizes God is calling Samuel. Usually this passage focuses on Samuel's response. However, Eli's wisdom is a vital component. Samuel would not have perceived his calling had it not been for his aged mentor. Eli epitomizes the gifts God bestows to elders with strong faith and the ability to see what lies beneath the surface. Eli's ripened faith recognizes the voice of God in what the youth misinterprets. Let us give thanks for the elders in our communities who bring wisdom to us.

**Samuel answered,
“Speak, for your servant is listening.”**

1 Samuel 3: 10

STEWARDSHIP & HEARING GOD...

Speak, for your servant is listening. With those few words **Samuel** humbles himself and declares his loyalty and obedience to God. There are perhaps for many of us challenges in those words. Initially **Samuel** responds *Here I am*, but thinks it was Eli who called him. The idea of being a servant and the willingness to serve are what may be trials for us in terms of how we live.

Samuel does not recognize the voice of the Lord. That, too, may be a problem for us. First we need to be listening. Are we, or are we merely going through the motions? Responding to God with *Here I am* is a magnificent way to react to God. It is not that God does not know where we are, but saying that can serve as a reminder to us that we are stewards, servants to Him, and it implies we are prepared to hear what He wants us to do.

Here I am is said numerous times by those in the Old Testament including **Abraham, Jacob, Moses, Isaiah**, and by **Ananias** in the New Testament. When Jesus says, *Come follow me*, as He does to us, do we hear Him, and even more important do we respond and do we follow?

In order to do that properly we have to be prepared to serve Him and others. Thus, like Samuel, we need to listen, and then we need to serve. At a recent papal audience, **Pope Francis** said, *Love and charity are service, helping others, serving others. When you forget yourself and think of others, this is love!* Ω

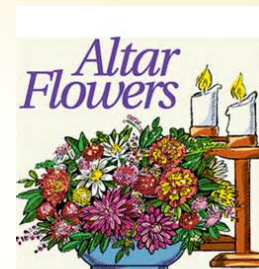

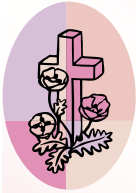

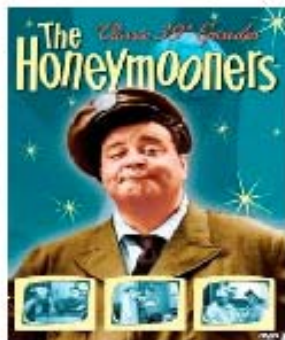

In preparation for the national celebration of Catholic Schools Week (January 28th – February 3rd), the annual collection in support of our Catholic schools will take place next weekend on January 13th and 14th. Through our Catholic schools, we are able to provide an excellent education and pass on our Catholic beliefs to our young people in a context that affects every aspect of their growth and development as persons, and equips them to face the challenges that life presents.
