STEWARDSHIP & TRUST IN THE LORD...

The United States Bishops post notes regarding all the Books of the Bible. In their introduction to Paul's *Letter to the Romans* (our Second Reading), they say: *Of all the letters of Paul, that to the Christians at Rome has long held pride of place. It is the longest and most systematic unfolding of the apostle's thought, expounding the gospel of God's righteousness that saves all who believe; it reflects a universal outlook.*

Paul's *Letter to the Romans* is in fact the longest of his letters in the New Testament (*Romans* is more than 7,000 words; that is much shorter, of course, than the shortest Gospel, *Mark*, which is still more than 11,000 words.) However, as stated by the Bishops, the *Letter to the Romans* explained in a more detailed way Paul's theology and spirituality than any other letter.

Regardless the length, today's reading contains a statement with which many of us are familiar, but which has great meaning: *If God is for us, who can be against us?* The significance of that is that if we are on the side of righteousness, which should be a major goal of our Lenten experience, there should be nothing to threaten us.

We understand that we will be judged. Paul's point is if we are judged "not guilty" by God, who can bring an additional charge with any merit? Or, if Jesus is our advocate, promoting our benefit, then who can condemn us? This is the time to place our trust in God, and in His love. Ω



STEWARDSHIP OF TIME AND LENT...

MAKE THESE 40 DAYS HOLY



Lent is a perfect time to teach stewardship. As we examine our lives and try to find something special to do for God, it is good to remember that whenever we give time, talent or treasure to God we are living as better stewards.

Time is one of God's most precious gifts to us, and we should thank Him for this gift by using all of it wisely. Stewardship of Time is about how you spend every minute of every day. Most of us feel we don't have enough time for all the things we want to do. Everyone is given the same amount of time: 24 hours each day, 168 hours each week. The question is simple: how do we choose to use our time? Time is a limited resource, so we need to prioritize how we use it, which means putting the most important things first.

Our relationship with God is our first priority—time spent in prayer—at Mass, in our personal lives such as through private reading of Scriptures and meditating on God's holy word. Our second priority should be our relationship with our family—time spent building a strong family unit filled with love and respect for life. Our third priority should be our relationship with our parish and the community within and beyond our parish boundaries—time spent supporting others in their faith journeys and daily life—ministering to those in need.

The Catholic faith is full of prayer forms and tradition that are available to all of us. Find a prayer form that works for you and truly cultivate your prayer life in order to connect and build a truly personal relationship with Him.

St. Bernadette provides many opportunities to enhance your Lent, but those may require the gift of time. Our Bread and soup suppers Friday at 6 with Stations of the Cross afterwards; two CRHP retreats; and today at 2 pm is the Lourdes Virtual Pilgrimage to mention just a few. Ω

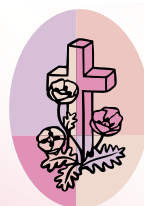
