Dear Friends,

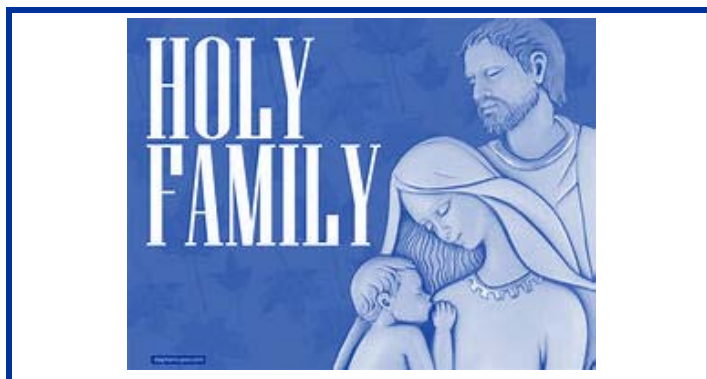
What a blessing it is for us to focus on the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph as we end the year 2017 and begin 2018.

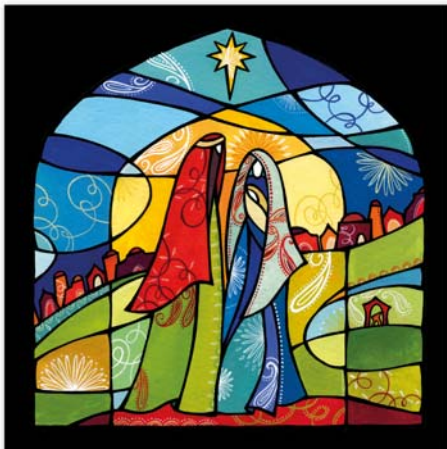

STEWARDSHIP & THE HOLY FAMILY...

The primary purpose of The Feast of the Holy Family is to present the Holy Family as a model for Christian families.

In Italy there is a saying, “*La famiglia é tutto*”— *the family is everything*. Our Holy Father Pope Francis has made families one of the focal points of his papacy. He organized a conference on families in 2015. Speaking to the gathered families, he said, “*You cannot have a family without dreams. I am very fond of dreams in families. For nine months, every mother and father dream about their baby. They dream about what kind of child he or she will be... You can't have a family without dreams. Once a family loses the ability to dream, children do not grow, love does not grow, life shrivels up and dies. So I ask you each evening, when you make your examination of conscience, to also ask yourselves this question: Today did I dream about my children's future? Today did I dream about the love of my husband, my wife? Did I dream about my parents and grandparents who have gone before me?*”

All of today's readings have to do with families and family life. The reading from *Sirach*, our First Reading, emphasized the Fourth Commandment, “Honor thy father and mother.” We are commanded to respect and love our parents. However, it is a two way street. The Gospel Reading speaks of the development of Jesus, and that should inspire parents to understand that our prayers are the same as Joseph and Mary's, that our children will become strong in spirit and filled with wisdom. STEWARDSHIP & THE NEW YEAR



In addition to the Holy Family Feast, today is also New Year's Eve. Stewardship is a commitment of mind and heart to the Lord; a way of life that needs constant renewal and transformation. This time of year has always been one of looking forward to a new year, reflecting on the changes we need to make in our lives and resolving to follow through on those changes. Perhaps those who seek to make resolutions to be better stewards might find inspiration in the following quick samples:

Stewardship of Prayer: Resolve to strengthen your relationship with the Lord. Notice how often you pray and what hinders you from praying. Commit to short, daily prayer times.

Stewardship of Family: Resolve to set aside more time to stay connected with your family. Eat dinner together, schedule regular dates with your spouse, plan family outings, and go to Mass together.

Stewardship of the Parish Family: Resolve to serve our St. Bernadette faith community in some way this year such as at liturgy, in the parish's outreach, or education and formation efforts.

Stewardship of Neighbor: Resolve to be a person of hospitality — to make time and space for others who enter your life. Be more aware of those times when a neighbor, coworker, fellow parishioner or stranger, needs a moment of kindness, a little attention or an affirming gesture on your part.

Stewardship of the Poor: Resolve to live with more compassion and in solidarity with those less fortunate. Remember the poor in prayer, and commit to helping relieve in some way the plight of those who are impoverished or marginalized. Ω

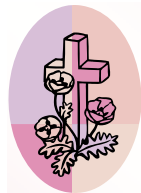
