Hearing Voices

We don't always want to hear the prophetic voice, which is God's word spoken by a human person. Most difficult of all, as Jesus himself observed, is to accept such a word from someone we know well. Since my father's death, I often find myself recalling one thing or another that he said to me, which I didn't understand or didn't pay much attention to then. Now, hearing his voice from within, I realize he was giving me a word that I needed: a kind and loving word.

The Hebrew prophets, whose words often went unheeded, were speaking to their own kindred. So, too, we easily reject the voice of our brother, Jesus, in all the ways that He speaks to us. But today, the psalms reminds us that we always can hear His voice. We may be surprised to discover how well we know His voice and how full of loving kindness it is. *Oh, that today I would listen to your voice, my God.*

STEWARDSHIP, JESUS, AND AUTHORITY...

In today's *Gospel Reading from Saint Mark,* it is reported that Jesus went to the synagogue and began to teach, but His teaching was somewhat different from that normally heard there *for he taught with authority and not as the scribes.* Often those who taught in Jesus' time (the scribes) simply quoted others, a variety of Rabbis.

However, Jesus taught with authority because He had authority. Jesus' divine message was not quoting other humans, but quoting God. Jesus was One with God so He knew what He was talking about. Jesus taught with authority because He believed what He was teaching. He was familiar with the information which allowed Him to teach boldly. People listening could perceive that this was someone Who knew.

Up until this time we have seen the Lord as the Son of Man Who submitted to His Father. He submitted to God in His Baptism, and to the Holy Spirit in the wilderness. To have authority also requires submission. We, too, are called to submit to God, but for us that is sometimes challenging because it requires humility, something that is not easy for many of us.

Later in the *Gospel of John* there is another account of the Lord teaching at the Temple. He is challenged, and His response is quite simply, *My teaching is not from myself; it comes from the one who sent me.* We are not divine, but we, too, are sent. Ω



STEWARDSHIP & COMMITMENT...



This weekend is what we call here at *St. Bernadette Commitment Weekend*. It is a time for each of us to evaluate and consider how we are using our God-given gifts, and how we might be able to improve in that regard. It is something which challenges our sense of stewardship. Sometimes people are reluctant to "commit," to fill out the commitment sheets provided. That is a surprising response in a world which insists on commitment. Marriage is a commitment; taking out a loan is a commitment; a mortgage is most certainly a commitment. God expects commitments from us as well.

The sharing of money, time, and personal resources of all kinds is not an option for Catholics who understand what membership in the Church involves. It is a serious duty. It is a consequence of the faith which Catholics profess and celebrate. ~Stewardship: A Disciple's Response,

U.S. Bishops' Pastoral Letter on Stewardship

At the front of St. Bernadette to each side of the altar hang two stewardship banners as a reminder to us how important this is to the life of the parish, and to us individually as well. On one of the banners is a large message: "If not now, when?" For many it is a human weakness to put off things we know we need to do. This idea of being a good steward and sharing our gifts, whatever they may be, is something we need to do now, not later.

Commitment is defined by *Dictionary.com* as a *pledge or promise; obligation; involvement*. The *American Heritage Dictionary* defines commitment as *being bound emotionally or intellectually to a course of action or to another person or persons*; and *WordNet* defines commitment as *the trait of sincere and steadfast fixity of purpose*. Commitment to Stewardship as a way of life is all of this, and more. As believers, we have an obligation to become sincerely involved spiritually, emotionally and intellectually on a course of action, our way of life, as we relate to each other and to our God. Consider what commitments you can make.
