### Power and Glory and Water

The Lord comes down in a cloud to talk to Moses and bestows the spirit upon the others in his camp. But when even those who are not in the camp begin to prophesy, Joshua asks Moses to stop them. Moses refuses because he knows he does not control the Spirit, and he will not jealously guard it. That story is echoed in today's Gospel, when John warns Jesus that others have been healing in his name. Jesus does not rebuke those healers who aren't numbered among his followers. I love the idea that the Holy Spirit moves with that kind of power through creation, through clouds and mighty winds and tongues of fire. It will not be manipulated or restrained. It may come in power and glory to those who are outside our camp, and its presence may be regarded in as simple a human action as offering, as Christ says, a cup of water to drink.

### STEWARDSHIP & THE HOLY SPIRIT...

The Holy Spirit plays a part in each of today's readings, but then the Holy Spirit plays a part in everything. A prayer attributed to **Saint Augustine** reads: *O Holy Spirit, descend plentifully into my heart. Enlighten the dark corners of this neglected dwelling and scatter there Thy cheerful beams.* In both the *First Reading* and in the *Gospel*, the Holy Spirit is at work.

However, neither Moses in the reading from *Numbers* nor Jesus in the *Gospel of Mark* is concerned. Their followers express concerns about the seeming presence of the Holy Spirit in another or in others. Moses says, *Are you jealous for my sake? Would that all the people of the LORD were prophets!* Moses longs for all to be filled with the Holy Spirit.

Our Lord and Savior Jesus feels the same way. When St. John approaches Jesus and expresses a concern similar to that presented to Moses, the Lord responds, *There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me.*

The Holy Spirit is present within each of us, but we must turn to that presence for strength and inspiration. **St Catherine of Siena** makes reference to this power when she wrote, *Enrich your soul in the great goodness of God: The Father is your table, the Son is your food, and the Holy Spirit waits on you and then makes His dwelling in you.* Truly. Come Holy Spirit. Ω



### STEWARDSHIP & OUR CRUCIFIX...



After Vatican II a greater emphasis was placed on the altar, thus its movement to the center in order to be the focus of the Mass. At the same time, the role, and often the size, of the Crucifix was downplayed. Some beautiful crucifixes disappeared from many churches as a result. Here at St. Bernadette we sought a bit of a compromise. Of course, our new church was built long after Vatican II (almost 50 years as a matter of fact), but it basically followed the understandings which came out of Vatican II. In our church the altar and the Eucharist are rightfully in keeping with the desires of Vatican II. However, when it came to our Crucifix, a compromise was decided by Father Ulto and the Building Committee. Our Crucifix hangs dramatically far above the altar, almost seemingly hanging in mid air.

The story of how that Crucifix became such an important part of our new church is a bit interesting and fascinating. Although the decision had been reached as to suspending it and where it was going to be, the group struggled with what it should be like.

In the early days of the construction of the church, **Father Ulto** and **Monsignor Saporito** led a pilgrimage of parishioners to Lourdes, Spain and Fatima. One of the stops in Spain was in Zaragoza in the northern part of the country. Mass was celebrated at the Basilica Cathedral in Zaragoza, Our Lady of the Pillar.

As the Basilica was located in the center of the city, and the Mass was at 10:30 a.m., the pilgrims were given time to eat at one of the many restaurants on the large piazza in front of the church. However, Father and Monsignor opted to visit the many Catholic shops there.

They saw our Crucifix hanging in the window of one, and entered and bargained with the owner (this was Spain). With input from pilgrims, it was purchased for our church. The rest, of course, is history. Ω

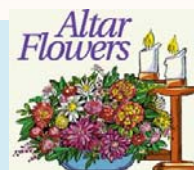

### October is Respect Life Month

#### *A Call To Defend and Build a Culture of Life*

The United States Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has designated October as **Respect Life Month**. During this month of October we are called in a special way to reflect on human life, the threats against it and how each one of us can protect all persons from conception to natural death. Once, most people saw life as God's greatest gift. Children were seen as blessings. Life was respected no matter how old or disabled or weak. Our own country was founded on the belief that the right to life is sacred and inviolable. But today our nation tolerates and sometimes promotes the intentional killing of human beings - by abortion and destructive embryo research, by executing criminals, by assisted suicide. We have slipped, often without realizing it, into what Pope St. John Paul II calls a *culture of death*.

The USCCB has chosen as a theme for 2018:

**EVERY LIFE**

*Cherished Chosen Sent*

*You who are my messengers, in you I place my absolute trust.  
Our Lady of Guadalupe*

Sometimes we may feel helpless seeing the heartbreaking lack of respect for human life. What can we do when our efforts seem small in the face of the **culture of death**? However, the Lord reminds us in *Matt 28:20*, that we can, by hard work and the grace of God, transform our culture into respect for life. As Christians we are called to witness to something greater and more perfect: a *gospel of life, hope and mercy*. We, as modern day missionaries, must care for others. The Lord reminds us that we must not be afraid to joyfully proclaim the truth of God's love, purpose, and plan for each person. He is with us always to fulfill this mission.

We can help people understand that state-sanctioned killing is unworthy of God's creatures, that there are other ways to protect society from those who have done great harm. Women in crisis pregnancies need to know that they are not alone, and that help is available for their pregnancy needs, adoption, and baby supplies. We need to be with those suffering terminal illness and their families, offering help, friendship and encouragement, never abandoning them.

In a society where millions of people have fallen prey to the false promises of the *culture of death*, let us witness to the mercy of Jesus. Let us invite all who have been harmed to experience His abundant love and healing.
