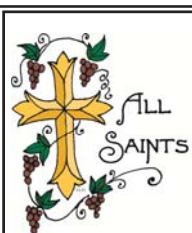
From Father's Desk...

They were at once charming, raw, honest and so expressive of deep gratitude, I couldn't help but pause, examine my own life, remember answered prayers and the healing grace of God—and follow Him on the way, grateful! *Lord, thank you for all you have given me.*

Stewardship... Live It!

Stewardship: a way of life for our St. Bernadette Parish Family...

STEWARDSHIP & PRAYER...

Our Gospel Reading from **St. Mark** relates the story of the blind man **Bartimaeus**. When **Bartimaeus** realizes that Jesus is near, he calls out, *Jesus, son of David, have pity on me*. We are told people rebuked **Bartimaeus**, and told him to be quiet. However, **Bartimaeus** persisted, calling out again, *Son of David, have pity on me*. There are important stewardship lessons here for us. The first has to do with recognizing Jesus as the Christ, our Savior. **Bartimaeus** calling him the Son of David indicates that the blind man realized Who Jesus really was. We need to come to that same realization and yield to it.

Another lesson has to do with the persistence of prayer. The blind **Bartimaeus** demonstrates persistence and determination. These are both good examples of prayer. Although blind, no one else there...evidently led him to Jesus, but he was not discouraged. We need to demonstrate those same attitudes. Prayer needs to be an important part of our stewardship way of living. Whenever we speak directly to Jesus, that is prayer. **Bartimaeus** also knew what he required of Jesus. He did not approach the Lord as if he was owed anything. All he asked was mercy. That is also a good example to us. Jesus says to the blind man, *Go your way; your faith has saved you*. It was his determination; he knew exactly who Jesus was; and he approached Jesus humbly—all good suggestions for us in how we live out our faith and practice our stewardship of prayer.
