In today's First Reading, a great number of Jewish people have just been freed to return from captivity in Babylon to their homeland in Israel. Ezra, the high priest, calls them together and commends them for their work in rebuilding the city of Jerusalem. In the Gospel, Jesus says He has come for a spiritual purpose—to bring glad tidings to the poor and those who are hurting. So, today we recommit ourselves to spiritual living according to God's ways. STEWARDSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

There are four traditional Pillars of Catholic Stewardship. The Stewardship of Hospitality is particularly important to us at St. Bernadette. Community Building is about creating and sustaining a vital faith community where parishioners feel welcomed and have a sense of belonging in their parish. If the parish community is supportive and spiritually nourishing, parishioners will want to share their gifts with the larger community and become involved in parish ministries.

One of the first ministries we established was our **Welcome Ministry**. For the past five years the coordinator of that ministry has been **Gail Barlowe**. Gail has actually served as a member of that ministry longer than that, but now she has stepped down from being in the leader position. We thank her for her willingness to serve and her stewardship example of service. It is a good example for us on this Commitment Weekend. **No one has stepped forward to serve as the new coordinator for this ministry. Might you be the person? If interested, contact Father Ulto.**



As many of you are aware we are blessed with a new **Music Director, Nathan Shrake**. Nathan points out that on this Commitment Weekend you might consider getting involved in that ministry. The **Music Ministry** is looking for good stewards of any age, with experience playing **ANY** instrument, but especially Drums, Bass Guitar, Electric Guitar and Piano. They are also looking for Adult Singers, especially men, for **For God's Grace**, our Contemporary Ensemble (9 am Mass), and the **Adult Choir** (10:45 am Mass). In addition, they are beginning choirs for young people—**Children's Choir**, for kids in 1st-5th grade, and our Youth Choir--**Young Spirits**--for young people in middle school-high school, as well as anyone— young or not young— for our Bell Choir. If one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it; if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy.

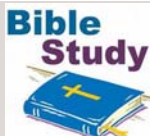
