### STEWARDSHIP & JUSTICE...

In today’s Gospel, taken from the sixth chapter of *Luke*, Jesus offers a very challenging, seemingly impossible approach to daily life. “Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. To the person who strikes you on one cheek, offer the other one as well.” It makes one want to say, “Seriously, Lord?” And He doesn’t stop there. Jesus adds, “Give to everyone who asks of you, and from the one who takes what is yours do not demand it back.”

It seems so unfair! That is, unless we look at this way of life from a stewardship point of view. Then, not only does it seem doable (though challenging), it actually makes perfect sense. A steward understands clearly that all he or she has and all that he or she is — life itself — is a gift from God given from an unfathomable abundance of love. This changes everything!

Does this mean we are to be passive “doormats” to anyone who wants to take advantage of us? Certainly not. Jesus explains this in the next verse of this passage when He says, ***Do to others as you would have them do to you.*** Jesus is simply asking that we approach others, and the sharing of our gifts, with this same attitude. He is giving us a definition here of real love, a steward’s love!

### STEWARDSHIP OF CREATION...



Not all of us live in Florida full time. At this time of year we are joined by many people from northern climates looking for some relief from the vestiges of winter. And what a winter it has been up there! Living in Florida—being in Florida—we need to thank our loving God for what we see around us and what we experience where it is always green and flowers always in bloom.

The Bible contains a profound message about the stewardship of material creation: God created the world, but entrusts it to human beings. Caring for and cultivating the world involves the following:

- ▶ Joyful appreciation for the God-given beauty and wonder of nature;
- ▶ Protection and preservation of the environment, which would be the stewardship of ecological concern;
- ▶ Respect for human life—shielding life from threat and assault, doing everything that can be done to enhance this gift and make life flourish; and
- ▶ Development of this world through noble human effort—physical labor, the trades and professions, the arts and sciences. We call such effort "work." Work is a fulfilling human vocation.

The Second Vatican Council points out that, through work, we build up not only our world but the Kingdom of God, already present among us. Work is a partnership with God—our share in a divine human collaboration in creation. It occupies a central place in our lives as Christian stewards.

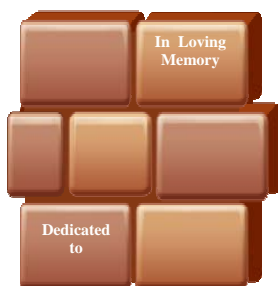
