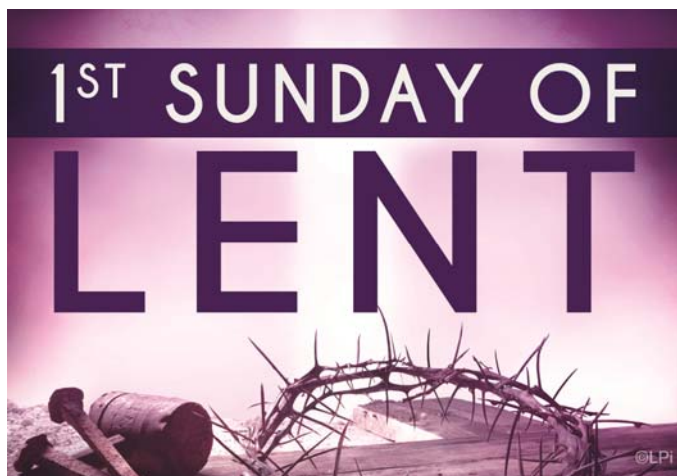
## From Father's Desk...

### Vulnerable for Love

On a retreat for young people I helped direct, the youth reflected on self-care. They knew loving your neighbor and loving yourself go together and are part of loving God. We asked them what they need to look after themselves and each other. They noted, wisely, that when they are hungry, or thirsty, they are vulnerable and then it's harder to be good to others.

Yet, the Church asks us, entering Lent, to embrace (in some fashion) hunger and thirst through fasting. The Church asks us to become vulnerable. Jesus spent 40 days in the desert, in physical and spiritual hunger and real temptation. So will we, even if not literally in the desert. Whichever form of fasting and vulnerability we take up this Lent, let's do it out of love. We need God's protection when we enter the Lenten desert. The Church doesn't ask us to go alone (as Jesus did). She urges us to go together. This is where Jesus is—with us. *Be with us, Lord, in our vulnerability.*

### STEWARDSHIP & LENT...

And so it begins — the holy and, for some, daunting, season of Lent. This is the season in our liturgical year when the Church encourages us to increase our prayer, fasting and almsgiving in order to enter more deeply into the mystery of our Lord's Passion and Death and to celebrate more fully His Resurrection.

Jesus, by His own example in today's Gospel, demonstrates the necessity of setting aside a period of time devoted especially to prayer and fasting as a means of strengthening our spiritual muscles. Just before the launch of His public ministry, He is "led by the Holy Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil." In imitation of Jesus, we should ask the Holy Spirit to lead us into the desert, too—the desert of our interior lives where our thoughts and desires reside. While our Lord was strong enough to withstand the temptations of the devil on His own, we most certainly are not! We must turn to the Holy Spirit and ask Him to show us where we need to grow, and then rely on the Holy Spirit for strength and guidance throughout these 40 days of growth. Perhaps we will be led to take on a spiritual reading program, or a daily time of meditation on the Scriptures. Maybe we'll be inspired to fast from our favorite food or social media fix and find a project that serves the poor in this community. If these spiritual exercises hurt a little, that means we are doing them right! At the end of this season, we will be prepared to enter into the grace-filled days of the *Triduum* and we will, through the power of the Holy Spirit, be resurrected as a new creation with our Lord come Easter. Let us begin!

### STEWARDSHIP & THE 40 DAYS OF LENT...



Are you looking for ideas to help you with your Lenten experience? Here are many ideas to fill the **40 days of Lent** and the beginning of the Easter season.

Of course, Lent began last Wednesday, so we are a few days behind. However, some of these suggestions, the first one for example, extend throughout the Lenten season and beyond:

*March 10:* Attempt a more intentional prayer life – start a habit in the morning and before bedtime.

*March 11:* Make a prayer basket at home - slips of paper or construction paper hearts (invite kids to participate) writing names or intentions that each person around the table picks out before each meal.

*March 12:* Attend a weekday Mass.

*March 13:* Pray the rosary.

*March 14:* Make a point of experiencing the sacrament of reconciliation at the beginning and end of Lent. Consider inviting someone who's been away from the sacrament to join you.

*March 15:* Give up meat on Fridays but don't substitute lobster - make fasting something that is truly sacrificial.

*March 16:* Pray for someone with whom you are out of touch.

*March 17:* Resolve to stop engaging in rumors, gossip, and negative chatter that devalues others. Ω

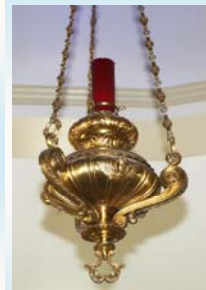

This movie tells the story of **Doctor Kermit Gosnell** who was an abortion doctor in Philadelphia. He is currently serving three life sentences and is thought to have killed hundreds perhaps thousands in a 30 year killing spree.

**Doctor Gosnell's** trial became hugely controversial after the mainstream media refused to cover it amid accusations of bias. This film has faced a similar fate with most mainstream media refusing to review it despite its success commercially. 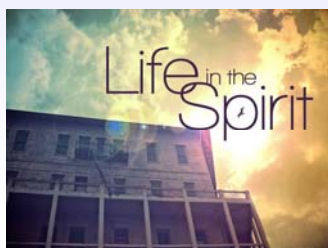

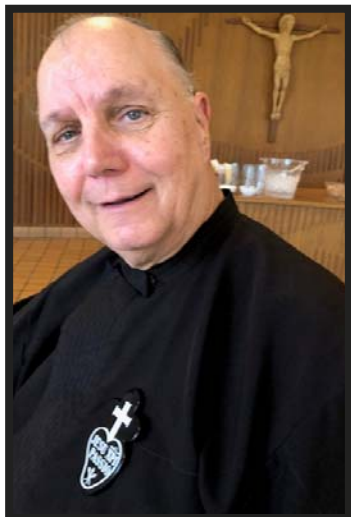

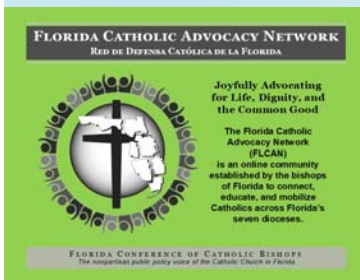
