At Mass today, we are given two powerful persons who teach us about the glory and power of our God.

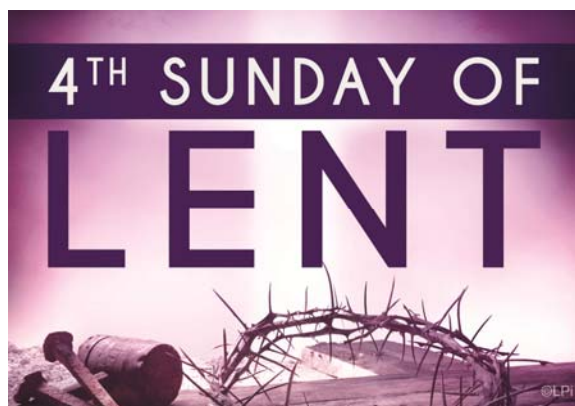
First, the Samaritan woman, who approaches the well to draw water for her thirst, but is given the gift of Jesus, the living water. She will never be thirsty again.

### STEWARDSHIP & THE PRODIGAL SON...

For many of us, Lent may be a season of doom and gloom, a time to feel badly about all the ways we are not “measuring up” in our spiritual lives. But this view could not be further from the truth. Lent is a season of refreshment and love, of awakening and rebirth. The Gospel Reading, the *Parable of the Prodigal Son*, is filled with this theme of awakening and the extravagant, life-changing love that the Father has for each one of us.

Most of us are familiar with this story — the younger son who has the audacity to ask his dad for his inheritance early, only to squander it sinfully away. It may make us bristle instinctively at his nerve when we hear it. But isn't that exactly what we do when we selfishly turn away from God (in big or small ways) in our own lives? We squander away the inheritance of grace the Lord has given us. In desperation from the mess he had made of his life, the son finally “comes to his senses” — awakening to the truth that he is a beloved son of a loving and merciful father — and decides to return home. His contrition is faltering and imperfect, but it is enough for the loving father.

In fact, as soon as the father catches sight of his son he is “filled with compassion for him” and immediately sets about preparing a feast for this son. What a beautiful picture Jesus gives us of our Father's love and mercy! And how it should inspire us — with just the tiniest bit of spiritual “spring cleaning” we can be sure we will be swept up in our Father's loving embrace and find ourselves feasting in His presence. That is what Lent is all about. Ω

A Parish Mission is a special time in a parish community when the community gathers together to gain further insight into a faith filled life. It is a time for grace and renewal of the parish through services and talks filled with stories, examples and meaning. Lent is intended to be a time of Christian action for us. To remind us of the many things we can do to improve our relationship with God and with others we have been offering daily suggestions for things you might consider to do to enrich and fulfill your Lenten promise.

We continue to offer suggestions of ways to live out Lent effectively:

- April 1: Attend our parish Lenten mission which begins today.
- April 2: Make time for family activities that are faith-related such as reading the Bible as a family.
- April 3: Keep a journal about your spiritual highs/lows.
- April 4: Make a playlist of spiritual music that you enjoy and share it with a friend.
- April 5: Embrace periods of silence in each day.
- April 6: Commit to a parish ministry or try a different ministry from the one in which you are currently engaged.
- April 7: Cut your media consumption to open time for prayer or scripture reading. Start and end each day free from the influence of the media. Ω

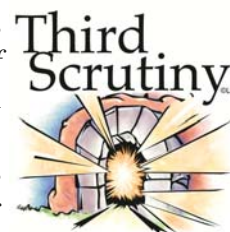
