From Father's Desk...

Dear Friends,

On this Fifth Sunday of Lent, the last Sunday before Palm Sunday and Passion (Holy) Week, we observe the soon to be crucified Jesus writing or perhaps doodling on the ground. Don't you wish you knew what He was writing? Most importantly, though, is the scene itself. In the Gospel of *John 8:1-11*, a woman caught in serious sin, in this case, adultery, is about to be stoned to death—a proper sentence according to the law of Moses. But Jesus shows what His Death is about to do: create a new Law, founded on love and compassion. Thus, He doodles on the ground, after uttering the wonderful words: *Let those of you without sin cast the first stone.*

How appropriate then, that we prepare for our Lenten Day of Reconciliation on Monday, April 15 by meditating on the Gospel. May we receive the Lord Jesus' forgiveness and healing, that we may celebrate Easter fully reconciled with God and with one another.

STEWARDSHIP & SIN...

Once again this week, we are reminded of what a loving and merciful God we serve. The theme of the readings for this **Fifth Sunday of Lent** is summed up beautifully in today's Gospel passage from **John**, which recounts the story of the woman caught in adultery. After all those who would have stoned this woman leave the scene, Christ says to her, *Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin anymore.*

When we turn to God for forgiveness, He is indeed gracious and merciful. So much so, that not only will He forgive our sins without condemnation, He will make us completely new creations in Christ. What is more amazing is that this all-perfect and holy God of ours draws so very near to us. Our sins do not drive Him from us, but rather to us so that He can set us free from them. Look carefully at Christ's actions and posture in the Gospel reading as He deals with the crowd of people, the Scribes and Pharisees, and the adulterous woman. *All the people started coming to Him and he sat down and taught them.... He bent down and began to write with His finger.* He "straightened up" when He confronted the Scribes and Pharisees about their own sins. And he "straightened up" when He assured the woman that He did not condemn her for her past. Like a skilled teacher, Christ bends down to where we are. He sits among us. He stands to confront us when needed, and He stands to look us in the eye to remind us of our true dignity.

We're all unworthy of the great privilege of serving Him. But that is simply cause for greater joy in serving Him with all our hearts. Ω

April 13: Park in the farthest parking spot away from the church, or the store, or the movies. Offer your long walk as a sacrifice.

April 14: Send a complimentary letter to a legislator or government employee.

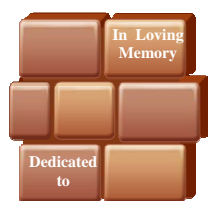
